The Court makes preliminary remarks. Counsel for Defendant, Dennise Merdjanian, P. consents to extend the temporary restraining order ("TRO") for another 14 days and requests to continue this hearing as he was just retained and has not had an opportunity to review documents. With no opposition from Plaintiff's counsel, the Court GRANTS the request. The Court hears arguments from Objector's counsel,

Esq., that Objectors, Student Processing Center Group LLC and SPCTWO LLC, should not be included in the TRO. Motion DENIED. The TRO stands as is and shall be extended to end of business on December 19, 2024. IT IS ORDERED the preliminary injunction shall issue only as to Defendant Superior Servicing LLC because Superior failed to appear or object.
